HeartStrings Pattern: H90 - 3019

Feather Soft

Take a flight of fantasy as you knit Feather Soft Scarf.

The stitch pattern is nicely engaging, yet repeatable enough to let the mind relax while the fingers click the needles.

Finish with an easy finger blocking to accentuate the gentle curves along the edges. Then enjoy wearing the soft feather of a scarf YOU made.



Finished Size 8" by 68" (20.32 cm by 172.72 cm) after light finger blocking; guidance for adjusting the size is included in the project instructions; if adjusting size, plan accordingly for more or less yarn

Yarn 325 yards (300 m) fingering weight; shown knitted with Mountain Colors *Louisa* cashmere/silk yarn in color *Hummingbird*

Gauge Approximately 21½ stitches and 19½ rows = 4" (10 cm) over blocked stitch pattern

Knitting Needles Size US 7 (4.5 mm) or size needed for gauge

Skill Level Advanced beginner

Stitch Instructions Charted and written

Construction Knitted flat from end-to-end; no seams to sew

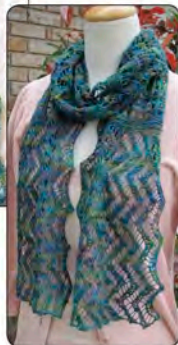

Lacy InterLACEments

Lacy InterLACEments Scarf features a sampling of stitch patterns for both knitted lace and lace knitting. Thus this sampler scarf is a study in both types of interLACEment.



Even if you have not attempted true knitted lace before because you thought it was too hard, you can do it now with this attractive scarf that works up quickly on only 35 stitches and relatively large needles.



Finished Size Approximately 7" by 70" (18 cm by 178 cm) blocked

Yarn 300 yards (275 m) fingering weight; shown knitted with Mountain Colors *Wood Cripe* in color *Headwaters*

Gauge Approximately 17½ stitches = 4" (10 cm) over blocked stitch patterns

Knitting Needles Size US 8 (5 mm) suggested

Skill Level Advanced beginner

Stitch Instructions Charted and written

Construction Knitted flat from end-to-end; no seams to sew

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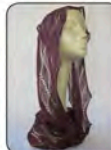
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HeartStrings Pattern: H190 - 3023

Winter Lace Loop

Winter Lace Loop is a lace weight infinity scarf that can be worn doubled or as a single long loop. Have fun knitting and wearing this delicate multi-fashion lace accessory.



Finished Size 8" wide by 66" circumference (20 cm by 168 cm) blocked

Yarn 450 yards (410 m) lace weight; shown knitted with Mountain Colors *Winter Lace* Junior silk/wool yarn in color *Red Willow*

Gauge 26½ stitches and 23½ rows = 4" (10 cm) over blocked stitch pattern

Knitting Needles Size US 4 (3.5 mm) suggested

Notions Crochet hook and waste thread for provisional cast on; tapestry needle; blocking board; rust-proof blocking wires/pins

Skill Level Intermediate

Stitch Instructions Charted and written

Construction Cast on provisionally, knit flat, join invisibly into a loop with Kitchener stitch

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
